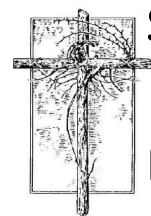

Unwanted Spectacles, Sunglasses and Hearing Aids - Thank you for your generous response, to help poor people in India, at a Special Clinic in December.

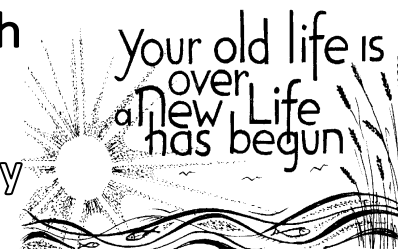
